# Update and Thanks from Daniel Colaner

Daniel Colaner has won the 2024 M.
Louise Miller – Paul E. Knox Scholarship
Competition sponsored by the Greater
Bridgeport Chapter of the American Guild of
Organists. The \$4,000 scholarship is awarded
to an undergraduate student pursuing study at
an American college, conservatory, or
university, leading toward a career in organ
performance and church music. He has also
won the Bart Pitman Memorial Scholarship
Competition. In addition to receiving a \$6,000
award, he will be featured on the Delaware
Valley Music Club's Young Performers Concert
in New Hope, PA next spring.

In August, Daniel was a laureate of his first international organ competition, receiving Second Prize and the Bach Prize at the Northern Ireland International Organ Competition. In addition to a monetary prize, he will receive concert opportunities at St. Paul's Cathedral, London, New College, Oxford, Manchester Cathedral, and at the St. Albans International Organ Festival next summer.

Daniel will begin a Bachelor of Music Degree in Organ at the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia this fall, where he will be serving as the Organ Scholar at the Episcopal Church of The Redeemer in Bryn Mawr, PA, and as a Wanamaker Assistant Grand Court Organist at Macy's Center City. Daniel would like to extend his heartfelt thanks to the members of the MacDowell Music Club of Canton for their generous support and encouragement over the years.
